Community Development

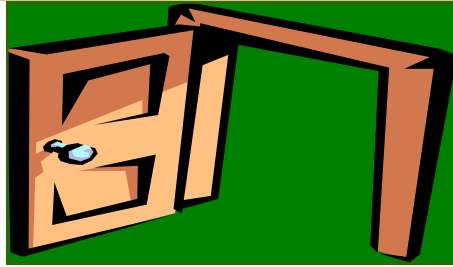
In consultation and collaboration with strategic partners and other interest groups, a wide range of community development activities are undertaken. These include but not limited to, social and infrastructural development projects.

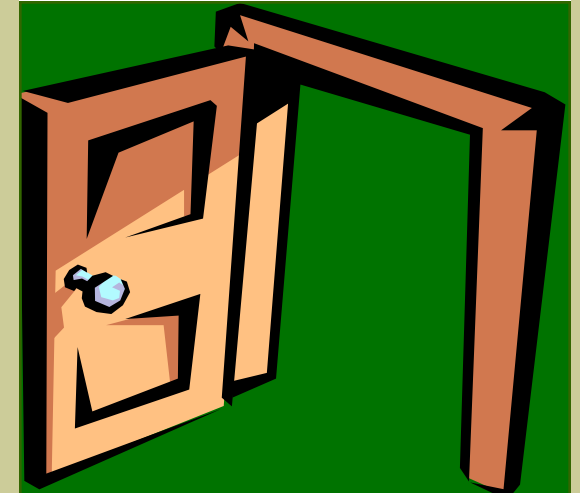

MISSION STATEMENT

The Grenada Citizen advice and Small Business Agency is a non government, non profit organisation whose primary function seeks to address the issues of unemployment and lack of economic opportunities in the Eastern Caribbean State of Grenada.

Established in June 1997, our mission is to initiate, coordinate and support programmes and activities that will provide small business opportunities, skills development training and employment opportunities to unemployed and under employed persons with particular emphasis on women and youth.

Within the last five years over one thousand persons have graduated under GRENCASE programmes. Over fifty percent have been able to find part time or temporary employment in their area of training, while about thirty percent were able to improve or start their own small business.

PROGRAMME ACTIVITIES

Information Technology

Information Technology training is offered in most software packages used in the workplace, but are not limited to, the office programmes.

Sewing

One of our on-going training course is in the area of sewing which is offered at both the introductory and advance levels. The overall objective of the course is to teach persons a skill that will enable them to be self sufficient and sustain a livelihood.

Summer Programme

The main aim is to keep children positively occupied and away from negative influences during the summer break. They are engaged in a wide range of activities that will facilitate creative thinking that will assist in their overall development.

Culinary Arts

Training in the area of culinary arts is offered on a periodic bases. This training usually targets potential foods vendors and persons seeking employment in the hospitality industry.

Business Development

Assistance is offered in the area of Small Business projects through advice and guidance. Training in Entrepreneurial development also forms part of the work of the organisation.

Personal Development

This is a standard component of all training programmes; with a wide scope which includes personal financial management, customer service, interview skills and career planning. This is in keeping with GRENCASE holistic approach to training.
